#### STOURBRIDGE BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Stourbridge (Hagley Road, No. 1) Traffic Regulation Order, 1965*

#### ROYAL LEAMINGTON SPA BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Royal Leamington Spa (Prohibition or Restriction of Waiting) Order No. 2, 1964*
