LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL

(Smithdown Road/Allerton Road) (No Waiting) Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Liverpool proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

- (i) to prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Monday to Saturday in each week on the southerly carriageway of that length of Allerton Road between its junction with Queens Drive and its junction with Mather Avenue; and
- (ii) to prohibit the waiting by vehicles for the purpose of loading or unloading goods in the above length of road between the hours of 8 a.m., and 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday in each week.

The exceptions referred to will enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road, or the services therein.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 26th October 1965.
