HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

The London-Fishguard Trunk Road (Cardiff Inner By-Pass) (Side Roads) Order 1965.

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. an Order under section 7 of the above Act providing—that four new roads which he proposes to construct at Gabalfa and Roath St. Margarets, Cardiff in the county of Glamorgan as connecting roads to the above-mentioned trunk road, will become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation, and
2. an Order under section 9 of the above Act authorising the Secretary of State
 - (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
 - (b) to stop up highways,
 - (c) to construct new highways, all in relation to the above-mentioned trunk road at Cardiff aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the highway authorities specified therefore in the Order as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies those authorities that the new highways have been completed and are open to through traffic.

Copies of the draft Orders and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 8th October 1965 to 8th January 1966, at the Welsh Office, Roads Division, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, and at the offices of the Glamorganshire County Council, County Hall, Cardiff, the Cardiff County Borough Council, City Hall, Cardiff and the Police Station, St. Mellons.

Any person may, not later than 8th January 1966, object to the making of the Orders, by notice to the Secretary of State quoting the reference HB 104/151/01 and stating the grounds of objection.
