LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930 WATER RESOURCES ACT, 1963

Essex River Authority
Tendring Internal Drainage District

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under sections 4 (3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act, 1963, proposes to make an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Essex River Authority under section 4 (1) (b) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, making provision for the alteration of the boundaries of the Tendring Internal Drainage District.

The Scheme affects lands in the Parishes of Little Bentley, Great Bentley, Weeley, Tendring, Little Clacton, Great Clacton, Thorpe-le-Soken and Frinton and Walton.

A copy of the draft Order, together with a copy of the Scheme and of the map referred to therein, has been deposited at the offices of the Clerk to the Essex River Authority, Rivers House, Springfield Road, Chelmsford, at the offices of the Clacton Urban District Council, Town Hall, Clacton-on-Sea, and at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Room 410, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1, for public inspection within the period ending with 8th November 1965, and may be inspected during normal office hours.

Copies of the draft Order, without the map, may be obtained from the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food at the address mentioned below.

Any objections to the draft Order should be made in writing and sent by post, addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, within the period mentioned above, quoting reference LDC 1096.

WATER RESOURCES ACT 1963

Devon River Authority

In pursuance of section 11 (6) (a) of the Water Resources Act 1963, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food hereby gives notice that the Devon River Authority have made an application for the variation of the main river map of their area.

Short descriptions of the proposals are set out below. The effect will be to bring the added water-courses under the Devon River Authority's jurisdiction for land drainage and flood prevention purposes.

Additions

1. A short connecting channel to the River Bray from the mill leat at Fullbrook, Chittlehampton.

2. A length of Harbourne River from the road bridge near Monkey Oak, Harberton (with alternative channels at Englebourne Quarry and Harberton-ford) to its confluence with the River Dart at Langham Wood Point.

Plans bearing the reference DEA 1, on which the proposals are more precisely defined by lines in green colour, are available for public inspection at the office of the Clerk of the Devon River Authority, Room A.119, County Hall, Exeter, and at the offices of the

Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Room 410, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1, during normal office hours until 9th November 1965. Any requests for more detailed information should be made to the River Authority.

A copy of the existing main river map may also be inspected at these addresses.

Any objection to the proposed variation should be made in writing and sent to the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food at the above address quoting reference LDC. 1123 on or before 9th November 1965.
