The Hitchin Urban District (Market Place Street Parking) Order, 1965 The Hitchin Urban District (Central Area) (One-Way Streets and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that on 12th October 1965, the Hitchin Urban District Council made an Order under section 81 of the Road Traffic Act 1960 and sections 11 (2) and 16 (1) of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act 1960, the effect of which is to authorise the use of the whole of the central portion of Improvement Act 1960, the effect of which is to authorise the use of the whole of the central portion of the Market Place (including that part of the existing carriageway extending diagonally from High Street to the northern end of Sun Street but excluding the perimeter road on each side of the Market Place) as a parking place for all classes of vehicles, other than hackney carriages and public service vehicles, subject to a maximum waiting period (except on Sundays) of one hour between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. The Order also empowers the Council, subject to certain conditions, to arrange for the removal and custody of any vehicle left in the parking place in contravention of restrictions imposed by the Order and the disposal of any such vehicle which appears to have been abandoned.

A previous Order made by the Council on 24th May 1939 under section 68 (1) (c) of the Public Health Act 1925, so far as it relates to the use of those parts of the Market Place which have hitherto been reserved

for the parking of vehicles, has been revoked.

And notice is also given that on 12th October 1965, the Council made a further Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is:

(a) to provide for the introduction of a system of one-way traffic in the following streets:

Direction of Traffic Flow
in a clockwise direction only so as to keep the centre of the Market Place on
the right-hand or off-side of the vehicle.
from Brand Street towards the Market Place. Market Place (perimeter road). High Street Sun Street from the Market Place towards Bridge Street. from Tilehouse Street towards the Market Place. from Bancroft towards Queen Street. Bucklersbury Portmill Lane (between Bancroft and the public car park).

(b) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles (except for the loading and unloading of goods and certain other permitted purposes) on either side of the perimeter road around the Market Place between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day except Sunday.

Each of the Orders referred to above will come into operation on 1st November 1965.
