Notice is hereby given that the Hampshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be that the driving of vehicles on any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule to this notice other than in the direction indicated opposite to that length of road in the second column of the Schedule is prohibited.

Lengths of road in the Parish of Ringwood in the Rural District of Ringwood and Fordingbridge

	<i>Direction</i>
The link road from Meeting House Lane to Gravel Lane	South-west to north-east.
Gravel Lane from the above link road to Southampton Road	North to south.
Meeting House Lane from Southampton Road to the above link road	East to west.

HASTINGS COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hastings County Borough (Robertson Street and Trinity Street) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 1965

Notice is hereby given that the Hastings County Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960 the effect of which will be:

- To prohibit save upon the direction or with the consent of a police constable the waiting of vehicles in the lengths of road set out in the First Schedule hereto.
- Except on Sundays, Bank Holidays, Christmas Day and Good Friday to prohibit between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. save as aforesaid the waiting of vehicles in the lengths of road set out in the Second Schedule hereto for longer than one hour in any three hours.
- To prohibit save as aforesaid the waiting of vehicles in the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Third Schedule hereto on the days specified opposite such lengths in the second column of the said Schedule.
- To prohibit save as aforesaid the waiting of vehicles for longer than one hour in any three hours in the lengths of road specified in the first column of the said Third Schedule on the days specified opposite such lengths in the third column of the said Schedule (except where such days are either a Sunday, Bank Holiday, Christmas Day or Good Friday).
- To provide in each case for exceptions to permit vehicles to wait for so long as may be necessary:
 - for passengers to board or alight,
 - for goods to be loaded or unloaded,
 - in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of obstructions to traffic or the maintenance of the roads and public utility services.
- To revoke those existing waiting restrictions affecting Robertson Street and Trinity Street imposed by the Hastings County Borough (Town Centre) (Traffic Regulation No. 2) Order 1963.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 17th day of November 1965.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

Robertson Street ...	The south-east side from its junction with Carlisle Parade to a point 34 yards north-east thereof. The north-west side between its junction with White Rock and a point 15 yards north-east of its junction with Claremont. The north-west side between the western and eastern boundaries of No. 42 Robertson Street.
Trinity Street	The south side (including the radius kerb at the eastern end). The north side between its junction with Claremont (including the radius kerb at the western end) and a point 18 yards east thereof.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

Robertson Street ...	The north-west side between the southern end of the radius kerb at the junction with Trinity Street and a point 15 yards north-east of its junction with Claremont and between the south-west boundary of No. 43 Robertson Street and the north-east boundary of No. 44 Robertson Street. The south-east side from a point 34 yards north-east of its junction with Carlisle Parade to a point 29 feet south-west of the south-west side of its junction with Robertson Passage and between a point 41 feet 6 inches north-east of its junction with Robertson Passage and the north-east boundary of No. 22 Robertson Street.
Trinity Street	North side from a point 18 yards east of its junction with Claremont to the western boundary of No. 42 Robertson Street.

THE THIRD SCHEDULE

The north side of Robertson Street from a point 15 yards west of its junction with Cambridge Road to a point outside the north-eastern boundary of No. 44 Robertson Street.	Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.	Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
The south side of Robertson Street from a point 18 yards west of its junction with Cambridge Road to a point outside the north-eastern boundary of No. 22 Robertson Street.	Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.	Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.
