

2. The length of footpath leading from the change in direction of the above footpath, following a southerly, then south-easterly and generally easterly direction to its junction with Oxford Street adjacent to No. 20 Oxford Street, a distance of 90 yards.
3. The length of footpath from the first change in direction of the above footpath, adjacent to Nos. 10 and 13 Victoria Gardens, running in a southerly then easterly and then southerly direction to a point on the un-named street off Farrow Street, 26 yards north of that street, a distance of 128 yards.
4. The length of footpath starting at a point on the un-named street between Nos. 61 and 63 Victoria Street 49 yards east of Victoria Street for 27 yards in an easterly direction meeting the above footpath at the first described change in direction.
5. The length of footpath running in a north-easterly direction from a point 10 yards east of the above footpaths westerly terminal and crossing the footpath described in 3, to a point 42 yards west of Oxford Street on the footpath described in 2, a total distance of 45 yards.
