Chailey Rural District Council (Iford) Public Path Diversion Order, 1965

Its effect will be to divert:

(a) part of bridleway No. 3E, starting at a point, marked "A" on the map hereinafter referred to, which is at its junction with bridleway No. 8, 40 feet east of the rural district boundary,

approximately 1,200 yards north-east of Balsdean Farm, and running north-east for 550 yards to a point marked "B" on the map; to a new line running generally eastwards for 200 yards over bridleway No. 8 to a point marked "C" on the map, approximately 210 yards west of Harveys Cross; then generally north for approximately 450 yards over a new right of way to be created, to the aforesaid point "B";

(b) part of bridleway No. 8, starting at point "C" aforesaid, and running generally east for approximately 190 yards over O.S. field 5535 to a point, marked "D" on the map, approximately 17 yards west of Harveys Cross; to a new line forming a loop between points "C" and "D" along and outside the southern edge of the field O.S. No. 5535.

The Darlaston Public Path No. 17 (Station Street/, Heath Road) Extinguishment Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that on the 8th day of October 1965, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed with modifications the above Order.

Its effect is to extinguish the public right of way running from Station Street to Heath Road which starts on the north side of Station Street adjacent to the eastern corner of the property No. 80 Station Street and runs generally west for a distance of 1,420 feet crossing the Darlaston Branch Railway Line to the path's junction with an unadopted road adjacent to Air Products Limited off Heath Road.

The Order becomes operative as from the 22nd day of October 1965, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application to the High Court.
