SECOND SCHEDULE

The Orders referred to hereunder will prohibit the driving of any vehicle the width of which, inclusive of any load, exceeds 6 feet 6 inches on the lengths of road specified under the title to each Order. Exceptions are provided in the Orders to enable any vehicle to be used on any of the roads concerned with the permission of a police constable in uniform or (if not a public service vehicle) when being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on those roads, or in connection with agriculture, timber haulage, any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of those roads or the services therein. A further exception is provided in the Order numbered (i) to enable there to be driven along the roads concerned any stage carriage of such width as shall have been authorised by the Traffic Commissioners for the South-Eastern Traffic Area for use on those roads.
