THE SOUTHERN RHODESIA (PETROLEUM) (AIRCRAFT) REGULATIONS 1965

In exercise of the powers in that behalf conferred on me by article 3 of the Southern Rhodesia (Petroleum) Order 1965, I, Arthur George Bottomley, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, make the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations, which may be cited as the Southern Rhodesia (Petroleum) (Aircraft) Regulations 1965, shall come into operation forthwith and shall be published in the London Gazette as soon as may be after they have been made.
2. There is hereby authorised—
 - (a) the importation by any person into Southern Rhodesia of petroleum carried in any aircraft otherwise than as cargo;
 - (b) the acceptance by any person of delivery of any petroleum which he intends or which he has reason to believe that another person intends to be so imported; and
 - (c) the making and carrying out by any person of any contract providing for such importation or delivery.
