

**BURY ST. EDMUNDS BOROUGH COUNCIL**

*The Borough of Bury St. Edmunds (Various Streets) (Restricted or Prohibited Waiting) (No. 1) Order, 1966.*

Notice is hereby given that the Bury St. Edmunds Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to:

- (a) Prohibit waiting in parts of Castle Road between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday.
- (b) Provide for the extension to midnight of the hours of operation of the unilateral waiting restrictions in Hatter Street, and the unilateral waiting restrictions in part of Guildhall Street.
- (c) Provide for unrestricted unilateral waiting, alternate sides, alternate weeks, in part of Out Westgate.
- (d) Prohibit waiting in parts of Cornhill on all days from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Exemptions are included in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services thereon.

The Order and a plan showing its effect in detail may be inspected between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays at the Town Clerk's Office, Borough Offices, Bury St. Edmunds.

**BURY ST. EDMUNDS BOROUGH COUNCIL**

*The Borough of Bury St. Edmunds (Crown Street, Honey Hill, Sparhawk Street, and St. Mary's Square) (Experimental) (One Way) (No. 1) Order 1966.*

Notice is hereby given that the Bury St. Edmunds Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which will be that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in Crown Street between its junction with Westgate Street and its junction with Honey Hill in any other direction than south to north; in Honey Hill in any other direction than west to east; in Sparhawk Street in any other direction than north to south; and in the diagonal road across St. Mary's Square from its junction with Sparhawk Street to its junction with Westgate Street in any other direction than north-west to south-east; for an experimental period of three months.
