Cambridge Midsummer Fair

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Cambridge have made application to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for the issue of an Order under sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act 1875, for the amendment of the Cambridge Corporation Act 1850, as amended by the Cambridge University and Corporation Act 1894 and the Cambridge Order 1912, so as:

- (1) to enable the Corporation, with the consent of the Minister, from time to time to alter or add to the tolls, rents, stallages and charges which may be collected in connection with the Cambridge Midsummer Fair; and
- (2) to alter the duration of the Fair and the days and hours on which it may be held as follows:
 - (a) the Fair to commence at 2.30 p.m., or such earlier hour as may be proclaimed by the Mayor,
 - (i) on the third Wednesday in June; or
 - (ii) if the third Wednesday falls on 15th, 16th or 17th of June, on the fourth Wednesday in June.
 - (b) the Fair to continue for the four days (exclusive of Sunday) next following the day of commencement and no longer.

PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT 1934

The Minister of Power hereby gives notice of the expiry of a prospecting licence granted under the provisions of the Petroleum (Production) Act 1934 and the Petroleum (Production) Regulations 1935 as amended. The licence which was granted to BP Exploration Company Limited and subsequently assigned to BP Petroleum Development Limited, Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London E.C.2, covered an area of 88 square miles in the counties of Dorset, Wilts and Hampshire.
