### CARLTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

#### *The Carlton No. 2A Smoke Control Order 1965*

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the

Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order (and of the map referred to therein) may be inspected, free of charge, at the Offices of the Carlton Urban District Council, Burton Road, Carlton, Nottingham, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 11th February 1966.
