

WORKINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Workington (Town Centre) (One Way Traffic) (No. 1) Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Workington propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit the driving of vehicles in the following lengths of road in the Borough of Workington in the directions indicated:

<i>Length of Road</i>	<i>Direction</i>
(i) Edkin Street between its junction with John Street and its junction with Thompson Street.	West to east.
(ii) Edkin Street between its junction with Thompson Street and its junction with Washington Street.	East to west.
(iii) Jane Street between its junction with Washington Street and its junction with Market Place.	West to east.
(iv) Nook Street between its junction with Guard Street and its junction with Market Place.	South to north.
(v) Pow Street between its junction with Udale Street and its junction with Washington Street.	West to east.
(vi) Ritson Street between its junction with Washington Street and its junction with Nook Street.	West to east.
(vii) Sanderson Street between its junction with Thompson Street and its junction with Washington Street.	West to east.
(viii) Thompson Street between its junction with Edkin Street and its junction with Pow Street.	South to north.
(ix) Udale Street between its junction with Pow Street and its junction with Bridge Street.	South to north and west to east.

2. To revoke the Borough of Workington (Traffic Regulation) (No. 1) Order, 1953, in so far as it relates to the length of road in Pow Street referred to in paragraph 1 above.

Amendment No. 8—Land at Listerhills*

Notice is hereby given that a proposal for the alteration of the above development plan was on the 31st January 1966, submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

The proposal involves an amendment of the Development Plan so as to re-allocate approximately 36.7 acres of land at Listerhills for the Bradford Institute of Technology and also designate the land as subject to compulsory acquisition for educational purposes.

A certified copy of the proposal as submitted has been deposited for inspection in the Town Planning Section of the City Engineer and Surveyor's Department at the City Hall, Bradford 1.
