The East of Snaith—York—Thirsk—Stockton-on-Tees—Sunderland Trunk Road (Shotton to Low-hills Improvement Side Roads) Order, 196 .

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that she proposes, in relation to the above mentioned Trunk Road at Shotton Colliery in the County of Durham, to make under section 9 of the above Act an Order which will—

Wetherby, Yorks
