The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that on 31st January 1966 he made the Construction (Working Places) Regulations 1966 (S.I. 1966 No. 94) and the Construction (Health and Welfare) Regulations 1966 (S.I. 1966 No. 95) after giving notice in accordance with section 180 of the Factories Act 1961 and Schedule 4 to that Act of his intention to make the said Special Regulations and after the holding of an Inquiry under the Schedule into objections made to the draft Special Regulations.

The Regulations replace corresponding provisions in the Building (Safety, Health and Welfare) Regulations 1948. They also extend protection to workers engaged on works of engineering construction; the 1948 Regulations applied only to building operations.

The Construction (Working Places) Regulations impose requirements as to the safe construction, use, maintenance and periodical inspection of all types of scaffolding; ladders; the guarding or covering of openings; corners, breaks and edges in floors, walls and roofs; work on sloping roofs and on or near fragile materials; and the provision of safety nets, safety sheets and safety belts. They will come into force on 1st August 1966.

The Construction (Health and Welfare) Regulations impose requirements as to first-aid and ambulance arrangements; shelter from the weather; accommodation for clothing and for taking meals; protective clothing; washing facilities; and sanitary conveniences. They will come into force on 1st May 1966.

The Minister of Power, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the Coal Industry Acts, 1946 to 1962, and the Regulations made thereunder, has re-appointed A. W. John, Esq., O.B.E., F.C.A., to be a member of the National Coal Board constituted under the said Acts.

PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT 1934

The Minister of Power hereby gives notice of the expiry of seven prospecting licences granted under the provisions of the Petroleum (Production) Act 1934

and the Petroleum (Production) Regulations 1935 as amended. The licences which were granted to BP Exploration Company Limited and subsequently assigned to BP Petroleum Development Limited, Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London E.C.2, covered areas including British territorial waters off the coast of the counties of York and Lincoln.

Details of the boundaries of the areas were published in the *London Gazette* dated 8th February 1963. Maps showing these boundaries may be inspected on application to the Ministry of Power, Petroleum Division, Thames House South, London S.W.1.

PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT 1934

In pursuance of section 2 (3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act 1934 the Minister of Power hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations 1935, as amended, he has granted two mining licences to BP Petroleum Development Limited, Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London E.C.2.
