PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) REGULATIONS, 1937 AND 1948

Romania

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice in pursuance of the above-named Regulations that he hereby recognises the Official Certificate of which particulars are given in the Schedule hereto as showing (a) that the meat to which it relates or the meat from which the meat product to which it relates was prepared, was derived from animals inspected ante and post mortem and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister; and (b) that all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to public health were taken in the dressing or preparing of the meat or meat product.

Where the Certificate is in the form of a label the recognition will apply only if the label is securely affixed to the meat or the package containing the meat product and if the label has not in any other circumstances or on any other occasion been used as an Official Certificate; and where the Certificate is in the form of a stamp, the recognition will apply only if the stamp is clearly impressed on the meat or the container, as the case may be.

The certificate hereby recognised is additional to the one reproduced in the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* of 12th May 1964.

SCHEDULE

For meat and meat products (including canned meat), a label or stamp having on it a design in the form set out below.



In place of the number 4 other establishment numbers may be inserted.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

*Lincolnshire River Authority**Black Sluice Internal Drainage District*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has now confirmed the Lincolnshire River Authority (Alteration of Boundaries of the Black Sluice Internal Drainage District) Order 1965 (S.I. 1966/107) made on the 15th October 1965 confirming the Scheme submitted by the Lincolnshire River Board under section 4 (1) (b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930 making provision for the alteration of the boundaries of the Black Sluice Internal Drainage District.

A copy of the Order may be seen at all reasonable hours at the office of the Clerk of the Lincolnshire River Authority, 50 Wide Bargate, Boston, Lincs, and at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the Land Drainage Act 1930, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question the validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that

the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.

WATER RESOURCES ACT 1963

Lancashire River Authority

In pursuance of section 11 (6) (a) of the Water Resources Act 1963, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food hereby gives notice that the Lancashire River Authority have made an application for the variation of the main river map of their area.

Short descriptions of the proposals are set out below. The effect will be to bring the added watercourses under the Lancashire River Authority's jurisdiction for land drainage and flood prevention purposes; watercourses deleted will be freed from this jurisdiction.

Additions

1. Part of Low Plain Catchment Drain from a point near Low Plain Farm to its confluence with Brigsteer Beck, Brigsteer.

2. A short length of High Shaw Pool from the tidal embankment south east of Lady Hall, Millom Without to its confluence with the River Duddon.
