The Salop County Council (Willow Street and Leg Street, Oswestry) (Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order.

Notice is hereby given that the Salop County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, amending the Salop County Council (Willow Street and Leg Street, Oswestry) (Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1962, which imposed (inter alia) a prohibition of waiting on the north-east side of Willow Street, Oswestry, from a point one yard south-east of its junction with New Street for a distance of 16 yards in a south-easterly direction. The effect of the proposed amendments will be:

- to permit vehicles to wait for a period not exceeding twenty minutes between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on the north-east side of Willow Street from its junction with the southern side of New Street for a distance of 17 yards in a south-easterly direction;
- to prohibit vehicles from waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in the length of Willow Street (Route B.4579) from its junctions with Welsh Walls and Castle Street for a distance of 40 yards in a north-westerly direction.
