TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1962

City and County Borough of Liverpool Development Plan Amendment (University and United Hospitals Precinct).

Notice is hereby given that a proposal for alterations to the above Development Plan was on the 9th day of February 1966, submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

The proposal relates to approximately 0.35 of an acre of land in Mulberry Street between Oxford Street and Back Oxford Street. It is proposed to allocate the land concerned as part of the University and United Hospitals Precinct and to designate as subject to compulsory acquisition the under-mentioned properties to secure that they will be used for development by the University of Liverpool:

Nos. 19, 21 and 23 Oxford Street, together with properties to the rear fronting on to Back Oxford Street.

A certified copy of the proposal as submitted has been deposited for public inspection at the City Planning Department, sixth floor, Commerce House, 13/17 Sir Thomas Street, Liverpool 2.

A copy of the proposal so deposited, together with a copy of the Development Plan are available for inspection free of charge by all persons interested between 8.30 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Any objections or representations with reference to the proposal may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 30th day of March 1966, on which it is made. Persons making an objection or representation may register their names and addresses with the Town Clerk, Municipal Buildings, Liverpool 2, and will then be entitled to receive notice of any amendment of the Development Plan made as a result of the proposal.

COUNTRY DEVELOPMENT PLAN

(a) *Aireborough Urban District—Yeadon Comprehensive Development Area No. 1.*

(b) *Swinton Urban District—Comprehensive Development Area.*

(c) *Dearne Urban District—Goldthorpe Comprehensive Development Area No. 1.*

Notice is hereby given that proposals for alterations to the above Development Plan were on the 11th February 1966, submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

The proposals comprise central area redevelopment and relate to land situate within the central area of

(a) Yeadon in the Urban District of Aireborough;

(b) the Urban District of Swinton;

(c) Goldthorpe in the Urban District of Dearne.

HIGHWAYS ACTS

BRADFORD CITY COUNCIL

Proposed Stopping up of Parts of Pretoria Road and a back road between Pretoria Road and Thornhill Terrace.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Bradford, the highway authority, intends to apply to the Magistrates' Court sitting at the City Hall, Bradford, on Wednesday the 9th day of March, 1966 at 11 a.m. for an Order that (1) those portions of Pretoria Road (a) commencing at its junction with Thornbury Road and extending in a north-westerly direction for 17 yards or thereabouts (b) commencing at a point 37 yards north-west of its junction with Thornbury Road and extending in a north-westerly direction for 60 yards or thereabouts and (c) commencing at a point 97 yards north-west of its junction with Thornbury Road and extending in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 40 yards or thereabouts; and (2) a back road commencing at the north-westerly extremity of Pretoria Road and extending in a north-easterly direction for 41 yards or thereabouts and then in a north-westerly direction for 28 yards or thereabouts and thence in a north-easterly direction for 35 yards or thereabouts terminating at its junction with Thornhill Terrace, be authorised to be stopped up on the grounds that they are unnecessary.

The effect of the said Order is shown on the plan which may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, City Hall, Bradford 1, at all reasonable hours.

At the hearing of the application the owners and occupiers of all land adjoining the highways to be stopped up, statutory undertakers, any person who uses the highways, and any other person who is aggrieved shall have a right to be heard.
