The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to give orders for the publication of the name shown below as having received an expression of Commendation for Brave Conduct (posthumous):

22972583 Sergeant Norman James GREIG, Corps of Royal Electrical and Mechanical Engineers.

On the 27th October 1965, Sergeant Greig, an Instructor at the Army Outward Bound School in North Wales, and 2nd Lieutenant Scarisbrick, an adult student in his patrol, went to the assistance of two boys in difficulties in the sea off the River Dysynni whilst taking part in a canoe training period. They reached the boys and gave them encouragement and instructions, until their own canoe became swamped and sank, due to the heavy sea that was running at the time.

2nd Lieutenant Scarisbrick swam one hundred and fifty yards to the shore to obtain a life line. He reached the beach, but was so overcome by exhaustion and cold, that he was unable to take any further part in the rescue operations.

Although perfectly capable of swimming ashore, Sergeant Greig elected to stay with the boys and there is no doubt that his complete disregard for his own safety and his encouragement and indomitable spirit played a considerable part in saving the life of one of them. Tragically the other boy and Sergeant Greig succumbed to the cold, and lost their lives by drowning.
