The Fareham Urban District (Traffic Regulation) (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting and Limited Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 1) Order 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Fareham Urban District Council in pursuance of sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, propose to make an Order the effect of which will be:

(a) To prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times on the following lengths of road (subject to the usual exceptions set out below):

Lengths of road in the Urban District of Fareham

. Harrison Road (part) East side between Osborn Road (East/West) and Southampton Road. 2. Colenso Road South side from its junction with Trinity Street for a distance of 430 feet in a westerly direction.

(b) To prohibit waiting by vehicles Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on the following lengths of road (subject to the usual exceptions set out below):

 Wallington Hill Both sides from its junction with Grove Road to its junction with Trinity Street. North Side. From its junction with Wickham Road (A.32) for a distance of 710 feet in a north-easterly direction to a point on the north boundary of No. 8 Wallington North.

South Side. From Shiplands House for a distance of 470 feet in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Wallington Shore Road.

Both sides from its junction with Wallington Hill for a distance of 70 feet in a northerly direction. 3. Broadcut
