- 22 All that part of the north side of East Street which is bounded on the north by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 290 feet east of the north-east kerb line of High Street eastwards for a distance of 15 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
23. All that part of the north side of East Street which is bounded on the north by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 43 feet east of the north-east kerb line of Queen's Way eastwards for a distance of 24 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
24. All that part of the north side of East Street which is bounded on the north by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 464 feet 6 inches east of the north-east kerb line of Queen's Way eastwards for a distance of 18 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
25. All that part of the west side of Grosvenor Square which is bounded on the west by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 29 feet north of the north kerb line of Cumberland Place northwards for a distance of 18 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
26. All that part of the south side of Hanover Buildings which is bounded on the south by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 162 feet west of the west kerb line of York Buildings westwards for a distance of 18 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
27. All that part of the east side of High Street which is bounded on the east by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 86 feet south of the south kerb line of Bernard Street southwards for a distance of 15 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
28. All that part of the west side of High Street which is bounded on the west by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 386 feet 6 inches north of the north kerb line of West Street northwards for a distance of 18 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
29. All that part of the east side of High Street which is bounded on the east by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 64 feet north of the north kerb line of East Street northwards for a distance of 27 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
30. All that part of the east side of High Street which is bounded on the east by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 8 feet south of the south kerb line of the access road into East Gate Street Car Park southwards for a distance of 30 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
31. All that part of the south side of Houndwell Place which is bounded on the south by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 10 feet east of the east kerb line of St. George's Street westwards for a distance of 12 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.

All that part of the east side of John Street which is bounded on the east by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 232 feet south of the south-east kerb line of Bernard Street southwards for a distance of 24 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
33. All that part of the west side of King Street which is bounded on the west by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 239 feet south of the south kerb line of Lime Street southwards for a distance of 21 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 34 All that part of the east side of London Road which is bounded on the east by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 187 feet 6 inches south of the north main wall of 11 College Place southwards for a distance of 12 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 35 All that part of the east side of London Road which is bounded on the east by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from the north main wall of 52 London Road northwards for a distance of 21 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 36 All that part of the north side of Marsh Lane which is bounded on the north by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 4 feet east of the east kerb line of Charles Street eastwards for a distance of 18 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 37 All that part of the north side of Ogle Road which is bounded on the north by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 387 feet east of the east kerb line of Portland Terrace eastwards for a distance of 6 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 38 All that part of the east side of Orchard Place which is bounded on the east by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 44 feet south-west of the south kerb line of Queen's Terrace southwards for a distance of 18 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 39 All that part of the north side of Oxford Street which is bounded on the north by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 416 feet south-east of the south-east kerb line of Bernard Street south-eastwards for a distance of 18 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 40 All that part of the south side of Oxford Street which is bounded on the south by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 15 feet east of the south-east kerb line of Threefield Lane eastwards for a distance of 12 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 41 All that part of the east side of Palmerston Road which is bounded on the east by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 236 feet 6 inches south of the south kerb line of Craven Walk southwards for a distance of 9 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 42 All that part of the north side of Portland Street which is bounded on the north by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 47 feet east of the east kerb line of Portland Terrace eastwards for a distance of 12 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
- 43 All that part of the south side of Queen's Terrace which is bounded on the south by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 142 feet 6 inches east of the south-east kerb line of Latimer Street eastwards for a distance of 24 feet, and which has a width throughout of 6 feet.
