Both sides. From its junction with Wellington Street westwards for a distance of 45 feet.

Between a point 45 feet east of its junction with Peacock Street and a point 45 feet west of this junction.

Between a point 45 feet east of its junction with The Grove and a point 45 feet west of this junction.

Between a point 45 feet east of its junction with Edwin Street and a point 45 feet west of this junction.

Wellington Street

Both sides. Between a point 45 feet north of its junction with Saddington Street and a point 45 feet south of this junction.

Peacock Street

Both sides. Between a point 45 feet north of its junction with Saddington Street and a point 45 feet south of this junction.

The Grove

Both sides. Between a point 45 feet north of its junction with Saddington Street and a point 45 feet south of this junction.

Edwin Street

Both sides. Between a point 45 feet north of its junction with Saddington Street and a point 45 feet south of this junction.

Milton Place

Both sides. Between its junction with East Terrace and The Terrace.

Prohibition of Waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.,
Monday to Saturday

Lengths of road in the Borough of Gravesend**Windmill Street**

West side. Between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 38 and 39 Windmill Street and a point 45 feet south of its junction with Wingfield Road.

Kempthorne Street

Both sides. Between its junction with Moscow Road and its junction with Church Street.

Church Street

Both sides. Between its junction with Bath Street and its junction with Princes Street.

Princes Street

Both sides. Between its junction with Wakefield Street and its junction with Church Street.

West side. From a point 45 feet north of its junction with New Road northward for a distance of 30 feet.

West Street

Both sides. Between its junction with Bath Street and its junction with High Street.

Royal Pier Road

Both sides. Between its junction with High Street and its junction with Crooked Lane with the exception on the north side of that part extending from a point 60 feet east of High Street eastwards for 54 feet.

Crooked Lane

Both sides. Between its junction with Royal Pier Road and its junction with The Terrace.

The Terrace

Both sides. Between its junction with Crooked Lane and its junction with Harmer Street.

Queen Street

East side. Between a point opposite the north side of Brewhouse Yard and its junction with The Terrace with the exception of that part extending for 75 feet in front of No. 24 Queen Street referred to in Part IV of this Schedule.

Terrace Street

Both sides. From its junction with Harmer Street westwards for a distance of 45 feet.

Milton Road

North side. Between a point 15 feet east of its junction with East Crescent Road and a point 45 feet east of its junction with Bentley Street.

The Grove

East side. Between a point 108 yards south of its junction with Saddington Street and its junction with Parrock Street.

West side. Between a point opposite the northern boundary wall of No. 4 The Grove and its junction

with Parrock Street with the exception of that part extending 45 feet north and south of its junction with Saddington Street referred to in Part I of this Schedule.

Edwin Street

West side. Between its junction with Milton Road and its junction with Parrock Street with the exception of that part extending 45 feet north and south of its junction with Saddington Street referred to in Part I of this Schedule.

THE GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

(Various Streets, Whitchurch) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be as hereunder:

- (i) to revoke the existing "Plough Cross, Whitchurch (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963", prohibiting the waiting of vehicles in Merthyr Road, Penline Road, Church Road and Old Church Road, Whitchurch, and replace them with provisions to the same effect.
- (ii) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles from Mondays to Saturdays inclusive:
 - (a) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto.
 - (b) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. for a longer period than 20 minutes in any period of one hour, in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto.
 - (c) for 24 hours per day, in the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto.
- (iii) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles from Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for 24 hours per day and the loading and unloading of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule to this notice.

Apart from the prohibition on loading and unloading specified in (iii) above, exceptions from the waiting restrictions will be provided in the Order to permit boarding or alighting from vehicles; loading or unloading goods; building operations, road maintenance or other similar works; and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 20th day of April 1966.
