The London—Carlisle—Glasgow—Inverness Trunk Road (Metal Bridge Diversion Side Roads) Order 1966

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that, in relation to the above-mentioned trunk road at Metal Bridge in the county of Cumberland, she has made under section 9 of the above Act an Order, the effect of which is to authorise the Minister—

- (a) to stop up highways and
- (b) to construct new highways all at Metal Bridge aforesaid and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Cumberland as from the date on which the Minister notifies the council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

The Catthorpe—Castle Bromwich Special Roads (Variation) Scheme 1966

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that she proposes to make a Scheme under sections 11, 20 and 286 of the above Act:
