The Ealing (No. 26) Smoke Control Order

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Ealing in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 10th May 1966, made an Order entitled "The Ealing (No. 26) Smoke Control Order" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke cay after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building in the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding Ten Pounds unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels include anthracite; its

fuels, gas and electricity. If confirmed, the Order will not come into force before the 1st June 1967, or before a later date deter-mined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

A copy of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge, at the Town Clerk's Office at the Town Hall, Ealing, London W.5, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks

at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 28th May 1966. Within the said period, any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
