

HIGHWAYS ACTS

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

Highways Act, 1959—Section 108

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Bedford in pursuance of their powers under section 108 of the Highways Act, 1959, intend to apply to the Magistrates' Court for the Borough aforesaid sitting at the Shire Hall, Bedford, on Tuesday, the 5th day of July 1966, at 10.30 a.m. for an Order for the stopping-up of the highway specified in the Schedule hereto on the grounds that the same is unnecessary.

A plan showing the effect of the Order for which application is to be made has been deposited at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Bedford, and may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours.

On the hearing of the application any person who uses the highway and any other person who would be aggrieved by the making of the Order applied for shall have a right to be heard.

That part of Russell Street in the Borough of Bedford extending from a point seven yards east of its junction with Chandos Street to a point 26 yards west of its junction with Canning Street.

CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

Calne and Chippenham Rural District Council (Box Mill, Box) Public Path Diversion Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th day of May 1966, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed with modifications the above Order.

Its effect is to extinguish the public right of way running from a point marked A on the plan hereinafter referred to on the east side of Mill Lane, Box, to a point marked B at the by brook immediately north-east of the Box Mill Buildings and to create a public footpath from a point marked C on the said plan also on the east side of Mill Lane, Box, following the south bank of the brook for about 380 feet to join the existing footpath at the said point marked B.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the plan contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at the Offices of the Rural

District Council at Nos. 1-4 Marshfield Road, Chippenham, Wilts, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on any weekday (Saturday excluded).

The Order becomes operative as from the 10th day of June 1966, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application to the High Court.

Notice of Submission of Public Path Order

The Rural District Council of St. Faith's and Aylsham (F.P.6 (Part) Millgate Street to The Meadows, Aylsham) Public Path Diversion Order, 1966.

Notice is hereby given that the above Order made on the 24th day of May 1966, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to divert that part of the public right of way at Aylsham running between Millgate Street and The Meadows beginning at a point approximately 60 yards from its junction with Millgate Street (between properties No. 43, Millgate Street and Bridge House), and running generally west across field O.S. 701 for a distance of approximately 138 yards to a point at the end of the unclassified road known as The Meadows, to a line running from the first point mentioned south-west along the eastern boundary of field O.S. 701 for a distance of approximately 34 yards and then generally north-west following the southern boundary of this field for a distance of approximately 125 yards to the second point mentioned.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Council Offices, Tudor Hall, Rose Lane, Norwich, Norfolk, and at the Office of the Clerk to the Aylsham Parish Council, 1 Norwich Road, Aylsham, and may be inspected free of charge between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Any objection or representation concerning the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 11th day of July 1966, and should state the grounds on which it is made.
