NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1952

Pursuant to section 275 (5) of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, and paragraph 1 of the 7th Schedule thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts and enactments amending those Acts, certain goods, to wit

one Kenwood Chef food mixer bearing serial No. 419250 (with bowl) believed to be the property of the said A. Abel;
one Hitachi transistor radio (KH 1007) bearing serial No. 24002949 and believed to be the property of the said A. Abel;

have been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that:

1. The said goods, being goods chargeable with a duty of customs, were without payment of that duty removed from an approved wharf (as defined in section 14 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952);
2. Alternatively, the said goods were articles contained in the baggage of the said James Fielding when he entered the United Kingdom or were carried with him at the time and they were not declared.
3. In the further alternative, in relation to each of the said goods the said James Fielding made a statement in answer to a question put to him by an Officer of Customs and Excise which he was required by or under the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, to answer being a statement made for a purpose of Customs, which the said James Fielding knew was untrue in a material particular. Whereby and by force of sections 44, 66 and 301 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, the said goods are liable to forfeiture.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the said Schedule to the said Act and if you are resident outside the United
