

GREATER LONDON COUNCIL

A Traffic Management Order entitled *The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) Traffic Order 1966* (G.L.C. 1966 No. 62) has been made by the Greater London Council. This Order, which will come into operation on 20th June 1966, enforces two specified right turns, prohibits three right turns and imposes one-way working around a specified island site in the London Borough of Lewisham.

HEBBURN URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Hebburn (Newtown and Ellison Street) Prohibition of Waiting Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Hebburn Urban District Council proposes to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in any of the lengths of roads set out in the Schedule hereto. The Order will contain exceptions which will allow any vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded and unloaded, or to enable a vehicle to wait, if it cannot be used for such purposes in any other road, in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road and the services therein.

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Hertford (Various Streets, Stanstead Abbots) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Hertfordshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

To prohibit the waiting of any vehicle between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in any of the lengths of roads in Stanstead Abbots specified below:

(4) *South Street* on east and west sides from its junction with High Street in a southerly direction for 45 feet.

(5) *Marsh Lane* on north and south sides from its junction with Roydon Road in a westerly direction for 30 feet.
