

22 feet from the kerb of Market Street; and the traffic island within The Parade.

(ii) To limit the permitted period of waiting at the above and following street parking places, as follows:

Upper and Lower High Street	30 minutes in any one hour
Albert Terrace, New Street, Market Place (East, West and South) and The Parade	1 hour in any two hours

to apply between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily except Sundays, throughout the year.

(iii) To provide that seasonal parking tickets shall be issued to cover a period of twelve months commencing on the 1st April each year, no reduction in price being made for tickets purchased within that period.

### MARGATE BOROUGH COUNCIL

#### *The Borough of Margate (Cliftonville Area) (Traffic Regulation Order) (No. 3) 1966*

Notice is hereby given that the Margate Borough Council on the 31st day of May 1966, made an Order pursuant to sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is:

1. To prohibit the driving of vehicles along the roads listed below, other than in the direction specified:

First Avenue ... ..	South to north.
Second Avenue ... ..	South to north.

St. Paul's Road ... ..	West to east.
Lewis Crescent ... ..	West to east.

2. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the roads listed below, between 8 a.m. and 12 midnight and to amend any existing Orders in these roads to comply with these provisions:

Roads	Length
Albion Road ... ..	North side: full length. South side: from Sweyn Road for 30 feet east; from Godwin Road for 30 feet west; from Godwin Road for 100 feet east; from Harold Road for 30 feet west.
