CHELTENHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Cheltenham (Parabola Road)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1966*

Notice is hereby given that on the 13th day of June 1966, the Cheltenham Borough Council made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from Mondays to Saturdays on the north side of Parabola Road in the Borough for a distance of approximately 12 yards from its junction with Montpellier Street.

Exceptions are made for picking up and setting down of passengers, loading, unloading, funerals and certain other essential purposes.

PORT TALBOT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Council of the Borough of Port Talbot (Water Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 1966.

Notice is hereby given that the Port Talbot Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960 amending the Council of the Borough of Port Talbot (Water Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1958 to the effect that for the distance of 250 yards in Article 1 of the said Order there shall be substituted the distance of 375 yards.

The effect of the Order is that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on either side of that portion of Water Street in the Borough of Port Talbot from its junction with Church Street (St. Joseph's Church) for a distance of 375 yards to its junction with High Street.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary
