

shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation, and

- (b) that the length of the Cemmaes Road-Mallwyd Trunk Road to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road as from the 1st April next after the date on which notice is given by the Secretary of State to the County Council of Montgomery (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the new trunk road is open for through traffic.

Copies of the Order, the title of which is "The Cemmaes Road-Mallwyd Trunk Road (Pont Dol-Dwymyn) Order, 1966" (S.I. 1966 No. 622), can be purchased, price 5d., either through any bookseller or direct from any branch of Her Majesty's Stationery Office.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the Welsh Office, Roads Division, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours. A certified copy has also been deposited at the offices of the County Council of Montgomery, County Offices, Welshpool, where it is similarly open to inspection.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from 24th June 1966, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
