WEST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

AMENDED ADVERTISEMENT

The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Sackup Lane, Darton) (Restrictions on Driving) Order, 1966.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of any vehicle the gross weight of which exceeds ten tons on the length of road known as Sackup Lane (District) Road at Darton in the Darton Urban District.

Exemptions are provided in the Order to enable any vehicle to be used:

- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any adjoining premises;
- (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with adjoining land or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled on that land;
- (c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of services therein;
- (d) in the course of military training operations, or
- (e) in connection with public transport.

A copy of the Order and of a map showing the length of road affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of either:

- (i) The County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Room 87), County Hall, Wakefield, or
- (ii) The Darton Urban District Council, Council Offices, Darton, near Barnsley.
