*No. 9) Public Path Diversion Order, 1966*

Notice is hereby given that the above Order made on the 1st day of July 1966, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to divert the public right of way running in a north-westerly direction for 130 feet across field O.S. parcel No. 6251, Northwood Farm, Chudleigh, to a line running west of Northwood Farm, Chudleigh, in a north-westerly direction across field O.S. parcel No. 6251 by a semi-circular route for approximately 205 feet until its rejoins the original path. (Devonshire Sheet SX8580, Revision of 1956).

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at the Rural District Council Offices, Kingsteignton Road, Newton Abbot, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

Compensation for depreciation or damage in consequence of the coming into operation of this Order is payable in accordance with section (31) (113 (2)) of the above Act, to which reference should be made.

Any objection or representation concerning the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 3rd day of August 1966, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

**COVENT GARDEN MARKET AUTHORITY**

*Covent Garden Market Act 1966*

Under section 35 of the Covent Garden Market Act 1966 the Covent Garden Market Authority are required to promote a Bill for the purpose of prohibiting at a future date horticultural marketing in the Covent Garden Area and providing for the disposal, not later than that date, of the lands of the Authority and other lands licensed for use for various purposes connected with wholesale horticultural marketing under section 21 of the Covent Garden Market Act 1961.

Before proceeding with the preparation of the Bill the Authority are arranging discussions with persons who have legal interests in lands in the Covent Garden Area which are likely to be affected by these proposals, being interests in such lands which extend beyond the end of 1971.

The Authority have written to such persons as are known to them to have such interests. If any person who has a legal interest extending beyond the end of 1971 in lands licensed under section 21 of the Covent Garden Market Act 1961 has not received a letter from the Authority on this matter they are requested to communicate with the Authority giving details of their interest.
