Length of Road	Direction
(i) along the northern side of the dividing islands, at the junction of the B.5051 with the A.53, a distance of 26 yards.	From the western to the eastern end, in an easterly direction.
(ii) along the central link of the dividing islands at the junction of the B.5051 with the A.53, a distance of 7 yards.	From the northern to the southern side, in a southerly direction.
(iii) along the western link of the dividing islands at the junction of the B.5051 with the A.53, a distance of 17 yards.	From the southern side to the northern side, in a north-westerly direction.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

(a) The east side of Ship Street, C.400, East Grinstead from a point approximately 33 yards southwards to its junction with Portland Road, a distance of approximately 288 yards.

(b) The west side of Ship Street, C.400, East Grinstead, from the north side of the entrance to Lovell's yard at a point approximately 76 yards south of West Street, southwards to its junction with Portland Road, a distance of approximately 250 yards.

## SECOND SCHEDULE

The east side of Brooklands Way, B.2143, East Grinstead, from its junction with Railway Approach, B.2143, south westwards to the Sub Post Office, a distance of approximately 223 yards.
