## PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

### SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL

#### *The Sheffield No. 13 (Handsworth) Smoke Control Order, 1966*

Notice is hereby given that the Sheffield City Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 26th day of August 1966, made an Order entitled the Sheffield No. 13 (Handsworth) Smoke Control Order, 1966, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order has been submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding Ten pounds unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st December 1967 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at my office at the Town Hall, Sheffield 1, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 16th September 1966.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1., object to the confirmation of the Order.
