SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Somerset (Various Streets at Frome) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restricted Waiting) (No. 1) Order, 1966.

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th day of September 1966, the County Council of Somerset made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to replace the existing waiting restrictions in force in various streets in the Urban District of Frome with the following restrictions:

(1) Waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the lengths and sides of road specified in the First Schedule hereto;

- (2) Waiting for a longer period than twenty minutes in any one hour will be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., in the length and side of the road specified in the Second Schedule hereto;
- (3) Waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in the lengths and the sides of roads specified in the Third Schedule hereto.
