**PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD)  
REGULATIONS 1937 AND 1948**

*Belgium*

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice in pursuance of the above-named Regulations that the Official Certificate printed in the Schedule to the Notice published in the *London Gazette* of 1st August 1952, is modified to the extent that in relation to canned meat the recognition is restricted to those Certificates which are completed by the insertion of one of the establishment numbers shown in the Schedule hereto.

The recognition of the Official Certificate in relation to meat and meat products (other than canned meat) is not affected by this Notice.
