LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Lancashire County Council (Brows Lane and Chapel Lane, Formby) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1966.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to revoke "The County Council of Lancashire (Formby Traffic Regulation) Order, 1938" as amended

by "The Lancashire County Council (Formby Traffic Regulation) (Amendment) Order, 1964" so far as it relates to the restriction of waiting in Brows Lane and Chapel Lane and to impose waiting restrictions as follows:

- (a) Prohibit parking on the north side of Brows Lane from its junction with Rosemary Lane to its junction with Elbow Lane.
- (b) Prohibit parking on the south side of Chapel Lane from its junction with Elbow Lane to its junction with Three Tuns Lane.
- (c) Restrict parking to a period of one hour in any two hours on the north side of Chapel Lane from its junction with Elbow Lane to a point 30 feet west of the traffic island at its junction with Three Tuns Lane, and on the south side of Brows Lane from its junction with Rosemary Lane to its junction with Elbow Lane.

The Road Traffic Act 1960 and The Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act 1960

The City of Lancaster (Off-Street Parking Places) Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Lancaster City Council, under powers conferred upon them by subsection (2) of section 11 and subsection (1) of section 16 of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960, propose to make an Order, the effect of which is intended:

- (1) To authorise the sites in the Schedules hereto as off-street parking places.
- (2) To regulate the use of such parking places, particularly as to the types of vehicles by which and the times and conditions on which they may be so used, and as to the removal therefrom of abandoned and unlicensed vehicles.
