

BANBURY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Banbury (Traffic Regulations) (Queensway, Woodgreen Avenue, Orchard Way and Ruscote Avenue) (One Way Traffic) Order 1966

Notice is hereby given that on the 3rd day of October 1966, the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Banbury acting by the Council of the said Borough made an Order under subsections (1), (2) and (3) of section 26 and subsection (4) of section 27 and of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit persons from driving, causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle on any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule set out hereunder otherwise than in a direction specified opposite to such lengths in the second column of the said Schedule.

The provisions of the Order will not apply to persons driving a mechanical road cleaning vehicle on any of the said lengths of road.

The Order will come into effect on 1st February 1967.

SCHEDULE

<i>Lengths of Road in the Borough of Banbury</i>	<i>Direction of Traffic</i>
Queensway—south-western carriageway—the whole road.	North-westerly (i.e. towards Broughton Road).
Queensway—north-eastern carriageway—the whole road.	South-westerly (i.e. towards Bloxham Road).
Queensway vehicular access between south-western and north-eastern carriageways situate 20 yards from the junction of Queensway with Bloxham Road.	South-westerly.
Woodgreen Avenue western carriageway—the whole road.	Northerly (i.e. towards Warwick Road).
Woodgreen Avenue eastern carriageway—the whole road.	Southerly (i.e. towards Broughton Road).
Orchard Way western carriageway—the whole road.	Northerly (i.e. towards Warwick Road).
Orchard Way eastern carriageway—the whole road.	Southerly (i.e. towards Broughton Road).
Ruscote Avenue—that part of Ruscote Avenue lying between its junction with Warwick Road and a point 350 yards in a northerly direction:	
(a) Western carriageway.	Northerly (i.e. towards Southam Road).
(b) Eastern carriageway.	Southerly (i.e. towards Warwick Road).

Ruscote Avenue the vehicular access between the eastern and western carriageways situate 20 yards from the junction of Ruscote Avenue with Warwick Road.	Westerly.
Ruscote Avenue the vehicular access between the western and eastern carriageways situate 190 yards from the junction of Ruscote Avenue with Warwick Road.	Easterly.
Ruscote Avenue the vehicular access between the eastern and western carriageways situate 280 yards from the junction of Ruscote Avenue with Warwick Road.	Westerly.
Ruscote Avenue the vehicular access between the eastern and western carriageways situate 350 yards from the junction of Ruscote Avenue with Warwick Road.	Easterly.

BOURNEMOUTH COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

- The County Borough of Bournemouth (Various Roads, Southbourne) No. 1 Experimental Traffic Order 196*
- The County Borough of Bournemouth (Various Roads, Boscombe and Pokesdown) No. 2 Experimental Traffic Order 196*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Bournemouth propose to make Orders under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which will be—

AS TO NO. 1 ABOVE:

- to make the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below one way in the direction also specified in the Schedule;
- to prohibit vehicles from turning right from Chestnut Avenue into Southbourne Grove;
- to prohibit vehicles from turning left from Grand Avenue into Southbourne Grove;
- to compel vehicles to turn left from Castlemain Avenue into Southbourne Road South;
- to prohibit the entry of vehicles into or the exit of vehicles from (i) *Parkwood Road West* at its junction with Beechwood Avenue and Parkwood Road East; (ii) *Darracott Road* at its junction with Beechwood Avenue and Parkwood Road East;
- with the exception of Public Service Trolley Vehicles, Emergency Service Vehicles and certain other vehicles to prohibit all other vehicles proceeding along the length of Southbourne Grove between its junction with the East side of Chestnut Avenue and its junction with the West side of Grand Avenue;
- to prohibit waiting at all times in the following lengths of road—(i) *Southbourne Road* from its junction with Parkwood Road to its junction with Carbery Avenue; (ii) *Parkwood Road* from its junction with Southbourne Road to its junction with Beechwood Avenue; (iii) *Seabourne Road* from its junction with Darracott Road to its junction with Wentworth Avenue and Beresford Road including Portman Terrace and Fisherman's Walk; (iv) *Beresford Road* from its junction with Southbourne Road to its junction with Southbourne Grove and Seabourne Road; (v) *Wentworth Avenue* from its junction with Beechwood Avenue to its junction with Seabourne Road; (vi) *Beechwood Avenue* from its junction with Parkwood Road to its junction with Wentworth Avenue; (vii) *Fisherman's Avenue* (East side) from its junction with Fisherman's Walk for a distance of 50 feet in a Southerly direction;
- to prohibit loading and unloading in the lengths of road specified in sub-paragraph (g) above during the hours of 9.30 a.m.—11.30 a.m. and 4 p.m.—6 p.m.
