The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that she has made an Order under section 153 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Devon) (No. 3) Order 1966" authorising the stopping up of a length of road at Tavistock Hamlets, Tavistock, Devon, and requiring the provision of a new highway, which matter was the subject of a Local Inquiry held in the Council Chamber of the Tavistock R.D.C. on the 16th July 1965.
