

GOSPORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Gosport (Brockhurst Road) (No. 1) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1966.

Notice is hereby given that on the 5th October 1966 the Gosport Borough Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the general effect of which is to prohibit or restrict the waiting of vehicles on the sections of Brockhurst Road, Gosport, referred to in the Schedule appended below.

The Order contains provisions for exemptions in the usual form to permit waiting for boarding or alighting, for the loading and unloading of goods, for funerals, for building operations and work in connection with public services.

THE SCHEDULE

(a) *No Waiting between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.*

(i) On the eastern side of Brockhurst Road extending in a northerly direction from a point on the boundary between Nos. 266/268 Forton Road to the junction of Brockhurst Road with Elson Road;

(ii) On the western side of Brockhurst Road from a point 15 yards north of its junction with Station Road to its junction with Military Road at Brockhurst crossroads but excluding a length of 65 yards extending in a northerly direction from a point 15 yards north of its junction with Norfolk Road, on which limited parking is permitted.

(b) *No Waiting at any Time*

(i) On both sides of Eastbourne Avenue extending in an easterly direction from its junction with Brockhurst Road to its junction with Beryl Avenue;

(ii) On the western side of Brockhurst Road from Road for distances of 15 yards in an easterly direction from their junctions with Brockhurst Road;

(iii) On both sides of Avery Lane in an easterly direction from its junction with Brockhurst Road to the entrance to the backway between Nos. 7 and 9 Avery Lane;

(iv) On both sides of Teignmouth Road for a distance of 15 yards in an easterly direction from its junction with Brockhurst Road;

(v) On both sides of Station Road, Harding Road, Mortimore Road and Cambridge Road for distances of 15 yards in a westerly direction from their junctions with Brockhurst Road;

(vi) For 15 yards in Brockhurst Road on each side of its junctions with the roads mentioned above;

(vii) From the western boundary of No. 5 Brockhurst Road round the kerb line to the junction of Burnett Road with Ann's Hill Road;

(viii) On the three sides of the traffic island at the junction of Ann's Hill Road with Brockhurst Road;

(ix) In Forton Road for 65 feet commencing at a point 36 feet east from the eastern boundary of the Market House Tavern to the boundary of those premises in Ann's Hill Road.

(c) *Waiting Restricted between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. to One Hour in any Period of Two Hours*

On the western side of Brockhurst Road

(i) Extending in a northerly direction from the western boundary of No. 5 Brockhurst Road to within 15 yards of its junction with Station Road, but excluding 15 yards on either side of the junctions with the roads mentioned in paragraph (b)(v) above where waiting will be prohibited at all times;

(ii) For a distance of 65 yards in a northerly direction from a point 15 yards north of its junction with Norfolk Road.

The Hastings County Borough (Theaklen Drive) (No Waiting) Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Hastings County Borough Council on the 29th September 1966, made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is with effect from 30th September 1966:

To prohibit, save upon the direction or with the consent of a police constable the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day except Saturdays, Sundays, Bank Holidays, Christmas Day or Good Friday in the

lengths of road set out in the Schedule hereto, except for as long as may be necessary:

(a) for passengers to board or alight;

(b) for goods to be loaded or unloaded;

(c) in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of obstructions to traffic, or the maintenance of the roads and public utility services.

THE SCHEDULE

Both sides of that part of Theaklen Drive running from Ponswood Road in approximately a south-west—north-east direction.

The south-west side of that part of Theaklen Drive running in approximately a south-east—north-west direction from its junction with Drury Lane to the south-eastern boundary of No. 2 Ponswood Road.

The north-east side of that part of Theaklen Drive running in approximately a south-east—north-west direction from the north-easternmost point of the restriction mentioned in the first paragraph of this Schedule to a point 521 feet south-east of the south-eastern side of the junction of Theaklen Drive and Drury Lane.

Notice is hereby given that the Hastings County Borough Council on the 29th September 1966, made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is with effect from the 30th September 1966:

To prohibit save upon the direction or with the consent of a police constable the waiting of vehicles between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) in the length of road set out in the Schedule hereto except for so long as may be necessary:

(a) for passengers to board or alight,

(b) for goods to be loaded or unloaded,

(c) in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of obstructions to traffic or the maintenance of the roads and public utility services.

Mercatoria—East side and north end from the western boundary of No. 12 to the northern boundary of No. 16.
