THE TRUNK ROAD (VARIOUS STREETS MACHYNLETH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State has made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting in any of the parts of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, or to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

Length and Sides of the Fishguard—Aberystwyth—Dolgelly—Caernarvon—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (A.487), in the County of Montgomery

1. That length known as Dell Street, which lies between its junction with Pen-yr-allt Street and a point 183 yards north-west of that junction.

2. The west side of that length known as Pen-yr-allt Street, which lies between its junction with Doll Street and a point 75 yards south of that junction.
