## WAGES COUNCIL

### WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

#### *Sack and Bag Wages Council (Great Britain)*

The Sack and Bag Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour proposals for (1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Sack and Bag) Order 1965 (Order S.B.(61)); (2) amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Sack and Bag) (Holidays) Order 1963 (Order S.B. (57)); and (3) the revocation of Order S.B. (61).

Particulars of the proposals may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within 14 days from 14th October 1966. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections.

The Minister of Power in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the Electricity Acts, 1947 and 1957, and the Regulations made thereunder has re-appointed Sir Hamish MacLaren, K.B.E., C.B., D.F.C., LL.D., B.Sc.(Eng.), M.I.E.E., and Sir Vincent Tewson, C.B.E., M.C., as part-time members of the London Electricity Board constituted under the said Acts.

### PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934

The Minister of Power hereby gives notice of the expiry of three prospecting licences granted under the provisions of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, and the Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, as amended. The licences which were granted to Coastal Oil Company Limited, 53 New Broad Street, London E.C.2, and subsequently assigned to

Total Oil Marine Limited, Seymour Mews House, Wigmore Street, London W.1, Auxirap (United Kingdom) Limited, 128 Queen Victoria Street, London E.C.4, Eurafrep Company Limited, 128 Queen Victoria Street, London E.C.4, Cofrasea Oil Company Limited, now at 16 St. Martin's-le-Grand, London E.C.1, Coparex North Sea Petroleum Company Limited, 80 Cheapside, London E.C.2, and the said Coastal Oil Company Limited, in association, covered areas of approximately 30 square miles, 28 square miles, and 33 square miles including British territorial waters off the coast of the county of York.

Details of the boundaries of the areas were published in the *London Gazette* dated 9th November 1962. Maps showing these boundaries may be inspected on application to the Ministry of Power, Petroleum Division, Thames House South, London S.W.1.

### PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934

In pursuance of section 2 (3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, the Minister of Power hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, as amended, he has granted a mining licence to BP Petroleum Development Limited, Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London E.C.2. Details of the boundaries of the area covered by the licence, described from the 2½ inch Ordnance Survey Maps and with reference to the National Grid, are given in the Schedule below.

##### *Northern Boundary*

From the point SK39317368 (near Whittington Moor) the boundary runs eastwards along the B.6050 road to the point SK40227358, thence continues eastwards along a road to the point SK40527358, thence southwards along a road to the point SK40527353, thence eastwards along the A.619 road to the point SK41167364 (near Brimington).

##### *Eastern Boundary*

From the point SK41167364 on the A.619 (near Brimington) the boundary follows a straight line south-eastwards to the point SK42407064 on the A.632 road, thence southwards along Moor Lane to its junction with Hassocks Lane at the point SK42046934.

##### *Southern Boundary*

From the point SK42046934 the boundary runs south-westwards in a straight line to the point SK40746851 (near Milehill).

##### *Western Boundary*

From the point SK40746851 (near Milehill) the boundary follows the railway north-westwards to the point SK38747060, thence northwards along the railway to the point SK38887323, thence north-eastwards along the railway to the point SK39127349, thence along a railway siding to the point SK39247362, thence along a road to its junction with the B.6050 at the point SK39317368 (near Whittington Moor).
