

Ancillary provisions enable the Minister to judge the suitability of a nominee and if necessary to refuse a nomination and request the nomination of another person, and further, if any nomination is not duly made the Minister may make the appointment after consultation with the Chairman for the time being of the Docks Board. Provision is also made in relation to the Local Board for the appointment of the chairman, the term of office of members and for vacation of office and the filling of casual vacancies, for the regulation of meetings, for the employment of staff and for the remuneration and expenses both of such staff and of members.

7. Incidental and consequential provisions dealing with the carrying on of the Conservancy Board's undertaking pending its transfer to the Docks Board, and the inspection of books.

8. For any mortgages charged on the dues funds or revenue of the Conservancy Board to take effect as mortgages created by the Docks Board charged on the revenue derived by the Docks Board from the exercise of the powers and duties transferred to the Docks Board by the Scheme and for the holders thereof to enjoy and be subject to the same rights liabilities and incidents against and in relation to the Docks Board as they would have enjoyed and been subject to against and in relation to the Conservancy Board if the Scheme had not been confirmed.

9. The continuance in force of byelaws, regulations, licences or consents made issued or granted by the Conservancy Board and in force immediately before the day of transfer and the amendment of the Pilotage Byelaws so far as they concern the constitution of the Pilotage Committee.

10. The costs of preparation, submission and confirmation of the scheme to be paid by the Docks Board.

### PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) REGULATIONS 1937 AND 1948

#### Yugoslavia

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice in pursuance of the above-named Regulations that the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* of 9th September 1955, for the importation

of meat and meat products from Yugoslavia is hereby modified to the extent that recognition is restricted to those Certificates which are completed by the insertion of one of the establishment numbers listed in the Schedule hereto.

This list replaces that printed in the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* of 23rd April 1965, which is hereby revoked.
