Exceptions will be provided in the Orders to enable a vehicle to wait for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any lengths of the roads, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of furniture or of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

## CARMARTHENSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

## The County of Carmarthenshire (Crescent Road,

 Llandeilo) (Prohibition of Waiting) OrderNotice is hereby given that the Carmarthenshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be that no person shall, except
upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.
