EPSOM AND EWELL BOROUGH COUNCIL

ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Essex (Market Square, Waltham Abbey) (Restrictions on Driving) Order, 1966*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Essex applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the use of the eastern carriageway of Market Square, Waltham Abbey, by any vehicles (including pedal cycles and tricycles) between 6 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Tuesdays and Saturdays.

Exceptions are contained in the Order authorising such a vehicle to use that road:

- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road; or
- (b) in connection with building operations or the repair and maintenance of the road or of the various services therein; or
- (c) with the permission of a police officer in uniform.
