To vary the existing order, which prohibited waiting To vary the existing order, which prohibited waiting at all times on both sides of Moorhouse Street and Ogden Street, by providing that waiting on the westerly side of Moorhouse Street and the northerly side of Ogden Street shall be prohibited only between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive. The existing prohibition of waiting at all times on the easterly side of Moorhouse Street and the southerly side of Ogden Street, and the existing one-way traffic operation along these two streets, from Brinksway towards School Street, will be continued.

. The County Borough of Stockport (Lucy Street Parking Place) Order 1966 (No. 23)—

To restrict the use of the existing street parking place on the east side of Lucy Street (off Old Chapel Street, Edgeley) to the hours between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in any day.

The Orders prohibiting waiting will contain exceptions to allow vehicles to wait for so long as may be necessary for boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, funerals, building operations or demolition, removal of obstructions, or maintenance of highway and public utility services.
