## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

CAMBRIDGE CITY COUNCIL Road Traffic Act, 1962, Section 28

The City of Cambridge (Traffic Regulation) Order (No. 4), 1966

Notice is hereby given that on the 10th day of October 1966, the Cambridge City Council made an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which is to introduce an experimental traffic scheme in Mill Road between the railway bridge and Cyprus Road and including the side roads leading from that section of Mill Road. The experimental traffic scheme will operate for a period of three months commencing on 1st January 1967, and will provide as follows:

- 1) On the north side of Mill Road between Cavendish Road and Sedgwick Street waiting will be limited to 30 minutes in any one hour.
- (2) Except as provided in (1) above, no waiting will. (2) Except as provided in (1) above, no waiting will be permitted between 8 am. and 8 p.m. on the north side of Mill Road between the railway bridge and Belgrave Road and on the south side between the railway bridge and Cyprus Road. The same restrictions will apply to the mouths of all side streets leading into these sections.
- (3) No loading or unloading of vehicles will be permitted between 8.15 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and between
