BATLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Batley (No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Town Council of the Borough of Batley in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of Clean Air Act, 1956 on the 5th day of October 1966, made an Order entitled the Borough of Batley (No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1966, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels, include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Batley, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 28th day of October 1966.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

Notice is hereby given that the Darton Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 27th day of September 1966, made an Order entitled The Darton Urban District Council No. 6 Smoke Control Order, 1966, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st October 1967, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Darton, Barnsley, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 29th day of October 1966.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
