DARTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Darton Urban District Council No. 7 Smoke Control Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Darton Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 27th day of September, 1966, made an Order entitled *The Darton Urban District Council No. 7 Smoke Control Order, 1966*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st November 1967, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Darton, Barnsley, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 29th day of October 1966.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

WALSALL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Walsall (Freer Street) (No Waiting) Order 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Walsall on the 26th of September 1966 made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles waiting at any time on the southerly side of Freer Street, from its junction with Goodall Street to its junction with Bridge Street, Walsall.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent any person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the length of road so referred to for so long as may be necessary to enable boarding or alighting from a vehicle, loading on to or unloading from a vehicle, or the use of a vehicle in connection with demolition works, road maintenance or the laying or maintenance of underground mains.

The Order will come into force on the 1st December 1966.

WALSALL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Walsall (New Road Willenhall) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Walsall made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, on the 26th September 1966, the effect of which is set out in the Schedule hereto.

The Order will come into force on the 1st December 1966.

SCHEDULE

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in Cross Street, Willenhall, Walsall in the County of Stafford, from the junction of Upper Lichfield Street and Cheapside in a westerly direction for a distance of 65 yards or thereabouts to the junction of Market Place as shown on the plan annexed to the said Order. Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary
